A range of volunteer opportunities would be available Monday-Wednesday from 9:30am until 3pm.

Main activities

- Help with transitioning pupils from class to yoga/dance lessons and back to class once sessions are finished.
- Support with setting up for sessions e.g. laying out equipment and tidying away.
- Support pupils who have difficulties with imitating/copying physical movement.
- Support pupils to find their full range of physical movement under the direction of dance/yoga teacher.
- Assist in creating a safe environment in which the pupil can express themselves within.
- Assist with calming techniques or physical prompting under supervision of dance/yoga teacher.

- Passion for dance therapy, movement therapy and sensory yoga.
- Experience working with children/young adults is preferred.
- Positive, helpful and patient personality.
- General understanding of characteristics and behaviours associated with autism.
