
COOKIE NOTICE



A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that are placed on your machine to help us provide a better user browsing experience. In general, cookies are used to retain user preferences, store information for things like shopping carts and provide anonymised tracking data to third party applications like Google Analytics. You can block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you restrict or block cookies this website uses, this may reduce the performance and usability of the site. We use persistent cookies and session cookies to collect data anonymously. A persistent cookie stays in your browser and will be read by us when you return to our Site or a partner site that uses our services. Session cookies only last for as long as the session (usually the current visit to a website or a browser session).

CATEGORIES OF COOKIES USED ON OUR SITE:

Strictly necessary performance and functionality cookies	These are cookies that enable core functionality and performance of our website including security, accessibility, network management as well as allowing you to log into secure areas of our website.
Analytical/performance cookies	These allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our Site when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our Site works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily. The cookies collect information in a way that does not directly identify anyone.

We may use third-party web services on our Site. The service providers that administer these services use technologies such as cookies, web server logs and web beacons to help us analyse how visitors use our Site and make the information displayed on it more relevant to your interests. The information collected through these means (including IP addresses) is disclosed to these service providers. These analytics services may use the data collected to contextualise and personalise the marketing materials of their own advertising network. The cookies collect information in a way that does not directly identify anyone.
